Elite Cohesion \u0026 Coercive Capacity Cohesion emerges as solution to a coordination problem among elites Unobservable Can observe and study shocks to the institutions that foster elite cohesion Expect negative shocks to elite cohesion to cause declines in coercive capacity, ceteris paribus

Conclusion Rare identification of cause of variation in coercive capacity Previous explanations, simple P-A model problematic Elites control CAs as a group Need to rethink stability of party/revolutionary regimes: Stalinism, Soviet influence rather than conflict/institutions
