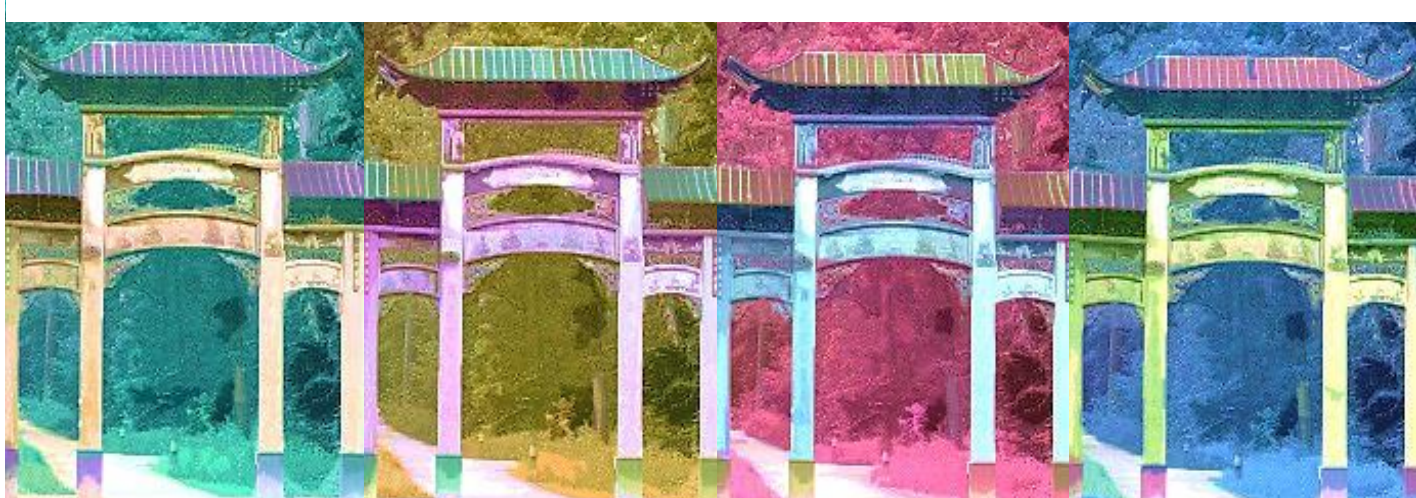

The tensions between national and global scales from the perspective of domestic policy making

Session objective: To identify national priorities in NDCs, consider the linkages to global drivers, and proposals for incorporating into modelling of NDCs
